Multi-Event Championships

The State Multi-Event Championships are styled off the Decathlon and Heptathlon events. Most age groups will run Pentathlons: 100m, 800m, Hurdles, Long Jump, and either Shot Put or Discus, depending on age and gender.

Older age groups add in additional events.

Unlike other competitions, the performances in individual events aren't overly improtant, its the overall performance that matters. In each event your performance scores points – the faster/further, to more points. These are tallied up to determine the overall position of each athlete.

Of course, PBs and records can still be calimed in each individual event, but it adds another level of cometition. Athletes who are good at everything, but not outstanding at anything usually go well here.

Those who have, or have nearly, qulified have been notified via email. If you think you have met the qualifying criteria, please email us, or see Maree on Sunday.
