Unless you are competing on Sunday, there is only one more opportunity to to qualify for the last two Stadium Events. This will be next Sunday, 19th of February. Please note that this corresponds with the senior athletics State Championships, and, as such, most of our committee will not be present. Additional helpers will be needed to arrive early and help set everything up. If not enough people arrive early to help set up, the competition will be delayed as needed to allow everything to be set up.

As a result of the twilight being cancelled, we have had to assign people duties for Sunday. If you wish to swap duties with someone else, that is fine, as long as you both know what is going on.

We are also taking nominations for the Centre Committee. More details on this are in the email. Remember, registration also covers the cross country season that runs until July. This season we intend to run training during the winter, adding further value. An end of season discount is now in effect for registration fees.

AGM / Presentation
