Hi everyone,

We are in the final stages of preparation for the upcoming season. An email with most details was sent out to all members a few weeks ago, if you did not receive this, please email us and we will forward it to you. For those of you who are not on TeamApp, we have instructions on how to join it on our website's homepage, should you wish to.

We held a Busy Bee last Saturday, and will hold another this Saturday, 2-4:30 PM, to finalise our preparations for the new season. If you have registered online, but wish to pay in person, please bring in your receipt and we can deal with that. In addition we will be able to take uniform orders. There is a discount of \$5 per athlete, up to \$10 per family, on the rego fee for those who pay in full across these two days.

Our shirts have a two year change over period between the old and new design. If you need a new shirt, you will need to place an order, as, to minimise costs, we will not be holding new stock. There is a 2-3 week turnaround between us placing the order and us getting the shirt, so we advise ordering quickly if you need one. Payment for the shirt will be a deposit of \$25 per shirt on placing the order, with the remaining \$25 upon receipt. We are accepting donations of 2nd hand shirts, to be resold at a lower price.

Important Registration Info

SALAA have finally gotten the online registrations system functional. If you are having any issues with the system, please contact SALAA – its their system, so if something isn't working there isn't anything we can do about it. Sports Vouchers can now be redeemed online. If you wish to pay in person you must print off your receipt and bring it to us when you wish to pay.

Please remember that ALL athletes - including returning athletes - must either be at least partially registered, or else doing a Come & Try in order to participate. For an athlete to be partially registered, they must have completed the online form and paid at least a \$5 deposit per athlete. To enable the first competition to run more smoothly, we will allow this payment to be made after the competition finished, but it must be paid before you leave the oval. This is primarily for insurance purposes.

Please not that, as always, an athlete is not properly registered until they have paid the full fee, and thus will be ineligible to compete at inter-centre competitions, gain points towards end of season trophies, achieve qualifying standards, and receive their registration packs, etc., until all fees are paid.

Other News

Training will be held on two weekdays from 5-6pm, with the exact days still to be determined. If you have any feedback as to which days suit you, please let us know, so we can take this into consideration.

Ingle Farm will be returning to the North-East Challenge this season. This is the only (realistic) opportunity we have to win something as a club, so we hope to see everyone at Enfield LAC on the 13th of November. All ages are welcome, and there is no entry fee.
