Our athletes once again distinguished themselves at the State Individual Championships, winning three gold, one silver; and breaking three State Records – a good haul considering only five athletes entered.

As the reader will likely have guessed, Nikki was responsible for the three Golds, and the State Records, as she has been the past several years. Nikki is now responsible for fourteen of the twenty State Records currently held by IFLAC athletes.

As for the other athletes, Bailey won silver in Shot Put, before illness took him out of contention for further medals. Thomas came fourth in the walk, at the age where the walk has the most entrants, a noteworthy achievement. William made the 200m final, but later events were limited by injury. Ebony came fifth in a competitive field in Triple Jump.

We are still awaiting a draft programme for Cross Country.
