As you should all know, we will be at **Playford Athletics Centre** (Formerly Elizabeth LAC) this Sunday, for the **Northern Region Open Day**. The Programme is available on our website for those who don't have it. This event allows you to chose your own events, so we highly recommend using it to chase down the last few State qualifiers you are looking for, whether they be for the Challenge or the Championship. With up to ten other Centres in attendance, it will provide plenty of extra competition for each athlete.

Remember that **Northern Zone Improvers** forms are **due back by Sunday**. If you haven't got you're from in, and are not attending Open Day, you can get it in tonight at Training. If you are unable to get to training tonight you will need to contact us to arrange an alternative. If you do not have a form, they can be found on our website.

Next week is the **State Relay Championships**, and as such there will be a **twilight competition** on the Friday. We are awaiting a final programme for Relay day, however a provisional one is available on our website. Those attending should know which events they are doing, however if there is any uncertainty please contact us ASAP.

Finally, we are calling for **additional volunteers** to arrive early to help set up the equipment prior to each competition, to minimise delays. This is particularly important for **Sunday the 19**th **of February**, as this clashes with the ASA (senior aths) State Championships, so we will be missing many of the people who are usually involved in set up. Without additional volunteers it is highly probable this competition will run significantly behind schedule.

Calendar Corrections

We would like to advise of two corrections to our Calendar. Improvers will be on the 26th of February, at Gawler, not on the 12th of March. By extension, the home meet that was advertised for the 26th of February will be on the 12th of March.

Northern Zone Open Day

The Programme for Northern Zone Open Day is now available in the family folders, and on TeamApp and the Centre website. Contrary to what we had advised, there is not a \$2.00 entry fee for Open Day, it is actually free.

Athletes are able to select the events in which they would like to compete, similar to PB Day. As with all Northern Region events, we will need parent help to run an event, in this instance, Shot Put; however we do not need to supply a chaperone/recorder for each age group as in the Northern Regional Games. A minimum of three people will be needed per hour, or 21 total. Preferably this would be 4 per hour and 28 total. It is an expectation of participation that each family will supply one person during the day.

Bring a Friend Promotion

For all home meets for the remainder of the Season, athletes are encouraged to bring friends or relatives to *Come & Try* athletics for free. A maximum of two sessions may be completed, after which they will need to register to compete for the remainder of the season. Please remember that an athlete is only covered by insurance if they complete the free *C&T* registration process on SALAA's website.

Remember, registration also covers the cross country season that runs until July. This season we intend to run training during the winter, adding further value. Starting from the 1st of February, an end of season discount also applies on registration fees.

AGM / Presentation

We have confirmed the date of our AGM / presentation as Sunday 9th of April. We are awaiting confirmation of the time. We will provide formal notice in early March.

Exceptions may be made in the event of serious injury, illness, etc., if we are aware of it. Additionally, all outstanding fees must be paid prior to the State Championships. All registered (and paid) athletes will receive a Certificate with their best results for the season, regardless of the number of meets attended.
